

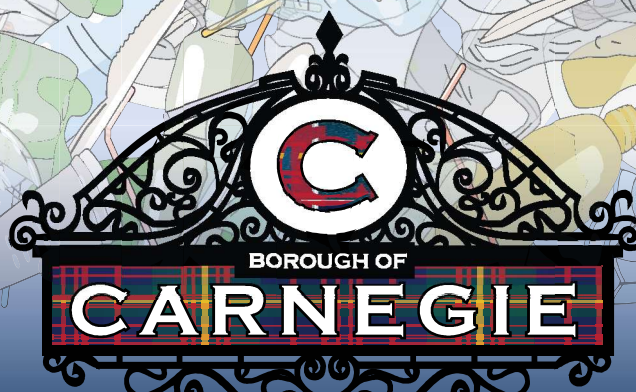

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SAFETY

Representatives from the borough and department of public works will be present. Gloves, Vests, and Water will be available but you are welcome to bring extras.

Clothing

- Always wear heavy duty work gloves (gloves will be provided but PLEASE bring a spare).
- Wear sturdy shoes, hats, long sleeves, and long pants to avoid falls, sun exposure, scratches, bugs and exposure to poisonous plants.

Visibility

- Always wear bright orange or yellow safety vests (provided).
- Safety signs will be at vehicular entry points to the cleanup area.
- Face oncoming traffic at all times and stay away from the edge when working on a roadway.

First Aid & Communications

- First aid kits with phone numbers for emergency services will be available.
- Carry a cell phone.

Liquids/Sharpies

- If any hypodermic needles are found, tell the DPW employee at your meeting station where it was found and they will collect and dispose in a designated "sharpies" container.
- Buckets will be available to collect sharp or pointed objects, such as broken glass and sharp metal pieces.
- Do not empty liquids from drink bottles (it may be bodily fluid). Dispose as trash, not a recyclable item.

Youth

- Minimum age of participation is 15. Persons under 18 must be closely supervised.

Unknown Materials

- Do not work on or near heavy operating equipment at any time.
- Do not remove any unknown, suspicious or known hazardous substances such as chemicals and toxic materials in containers. Call your 911 and the local DEP office team to notify them of suspected substance and location.

Animals

- Apply insect repellent or wipes prior to the event.
- Do not remove animal carcasses and be alert for snakes, rodents, and ticks.

Heavy Lifting

- Do not attempt to remove heavy items that you cannot move safely. Do not strain your back.

General

- Avoid overexertion and drink water or other fluids frequently in warm weather.

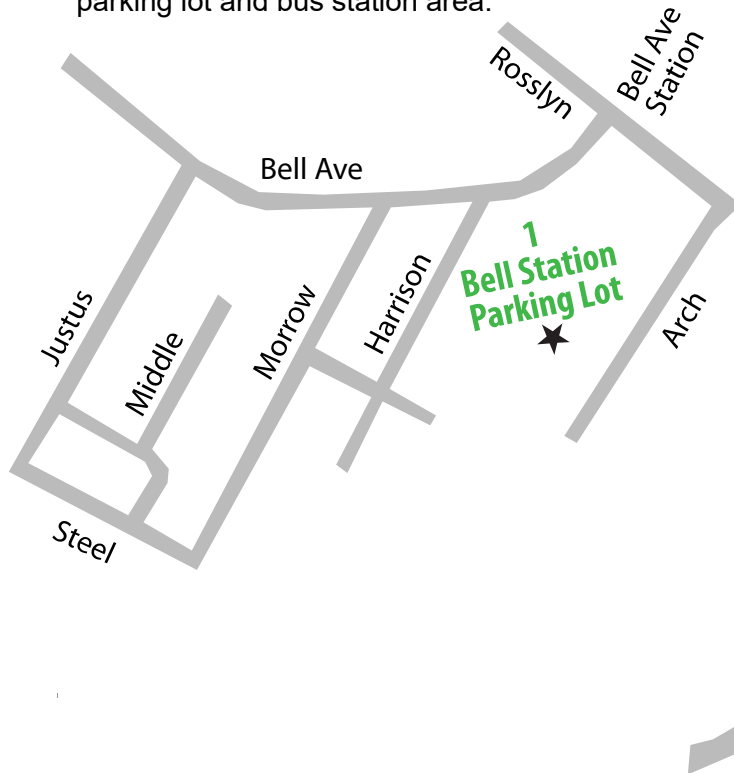
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Clean-Up Areas

Bell Station Parking Lot

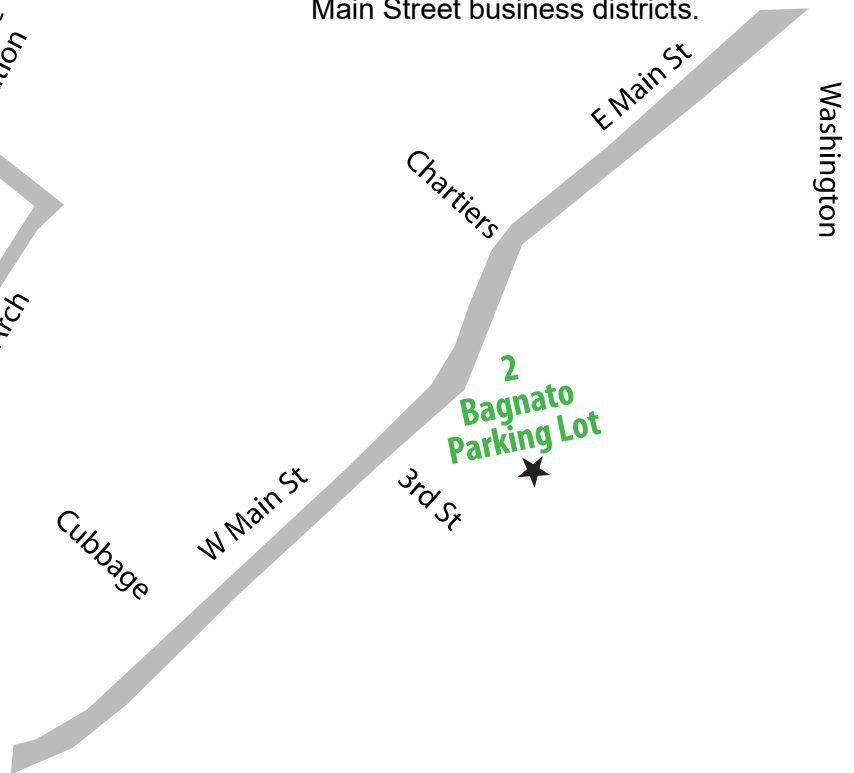

Meeting Site 2

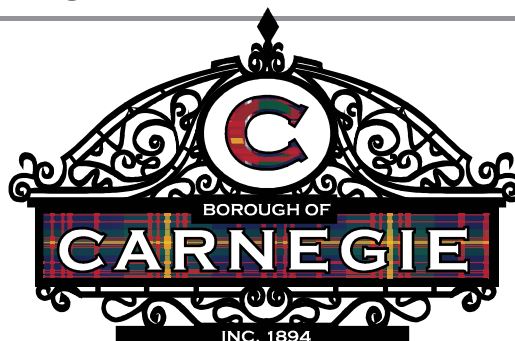
Bagnato Parking Lot
