

Carnegie Borough's new website received 1st Place Award Pennsylvania State Association of Boroughs

The Borough of Carnegie announced today each year *Borough News*, the official magazine of the Pennsylvania State Association of Boroughs, presents awards to boroughs for their newsletters and websites. The contest is an opportunity for boroughs to showcase how they communicate with their communities. The judging is based on content, clarity, and effectiveness. Entrants are separated by population category. This year in the 5,001 to 7,500 population category, the Borough of Carnegie received the first place honor for its newly designed website.

In 2015, the Borough of Carnegie, realizing its website was antiquated and lacking necessary information, collaborated with Carnegie resident, Deneen Underwood, to create a twenty-four hour communication system that enables individuals to review essential, up-to-date information about current Borough news and events, in addition to required documents necessary to conduct business within the Borough.
