To Whom It May Concern:

Gulisek Construction, LLC is currently under contract with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the above referenced project.

We will be performing work on the SR 3056 Chestnut Street for the next month and a half starting on Monday September 23, 2019. While we are working on Chestnut Street, there will be a 29-day one-way closure and detour in place. Traffic will be allowed to travel down Chestnut Street coming from Greentree Road toward Carnegie, but traffic will not be allowed to travel up Chestnut Street from Carnegie toward Greentree Road. This detour will be in place from Academy Street to Wabash Ave. The detour that will be implemented during this 29-day closure will utilize Route 50 (Washington Ave) to Greentree Road to Forsythe Road (this road turns into Chestnut Street).

If we are doing work in front of your home, you will still be able to have access to your driveway. We do though ask for your cooperation if we are working in front of your home that you follow our workers directions on when it is safe to pull in and out of your driveway. It may take a few minuets until we can make our work zone safe for you to drive in or out of the traffic pattern.

There will be day time and night time work going on while construction is taking place on Chestnut Street.
