Regular Curbside Collection

Household waste will be collected every week on Wednesdays, and recycling every other week on Thursdays. Place your recycling and waste pickup at the curb no later than 6:30 a.m. — late setout will be noted and may not be picked up. Household waste should not be placed curbside any earlier than 6 p.m. on Tuesday, and recycling should not be placed curbside any earlier than 6 p.m. on Wednesday.

Guidelines for Waste Collection

- All waste must be placed at the curb unless other arrangements are made with Republic Services®.
- Waste should be in properly secured carts (60 pounds or less) or plastic bags (35 pounds or less).
- Grass clippings and weeds should be in plastic bags and should not exceed 35 pounds; they will be picked up as regular waste.
- Hedge cuttings, limbs and branches should be securely tied and not exceed 48 inches in length; branches should not exceed 3 inches in diameter.
- One bulk item per week will be accepted at curbside. Items such as bookshelves or swing sets must be disassembled and cut into sections not to exceed 48 inches in length, weighing no more than 40 pounds. If you have more than one bulk item, you may contact Republic Services to arrange for more bulk items to be picked up for an added fee.
- Carpet should be rolled and tied in lengths not to exceed 48 inches.
- Appliances will be accepted at curbside as bulk. Refer to the next column for more information regarding appliances containing Freon®.
- Empty paint cans and/or dried paint is acceptable. Paint can be dried by air drying or soaking up with newspaper or kitty litter. Lids should be left off.

Recycling and Waste Notes

- Building materials cannot be picked up with your regular waste; however, they can be picked up for an additional fee.
 Please call 800.464.2120 to schedule a special pickup.
- Hazardous household waste (including paint thinners, cleaners, pesticides/herbicides, etc.) cannot be picked up.
- Stones, dirt, ashes and automobile parts including motor oil, wheel rims and tires cannot be picked up.
- Trees, branches and bushes cannot be picked up.
- Electronics Collection including televisions, desktop and laptop computers, monitors and other computer products: this is already included in your collection fees. Call Republic Services at 800.464.2120 to schedule a collection.

Holiday Service

There is no recycling or waste collection on the following six holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Recycling and waste collection will be delayed one (1) day if an above-mentioned holiday occurs Monday - Friday of a holiday week. If the holiday falls on the weekend, service will remain on a normal schedule and will not be delayed one (1) day.

Recycling

Recyclables should be placed loose in carts. Do not put recyclables in plastic bags. The municipality will be divided into two sections: A and B. Please refer to the street listing (right) and collection calendar (back) for your scheduled service.

Acceptable Recycling Items

- Clean paper, cardboard (OCC) and newsprint
- Rigid plastic food and beverage containers (#1 and #2)
- Aluminum beverage cans
- Soup/vegetable cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Steel/bi-metal food containers

All items should be **empty**, **clean and dry** before placing them in your recycling cart.

Unacceptable Recycling Items

- Light bulbs, mirrors, window glass and ceramics
- Polystyrene foam, plastic grocery bags and coat hangers
- Pizza boxes, paper towels and wet paper products
- Aluminum foil and any other metal that is not explicitly outlined as acceptable
- Plastic bags of any kind
- Plastics #3 #7
- Light bulbs, mirrors, window glass and ceramics
- Glass food and beverage containers (all colors)

Items Containing Freon®

Republic Services will collect items such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers, etc. However, the item must have a sticker certifying that the Freon has been removed. If it does not have the sticker, it will not be picked up. It is unlawful for Republic Services to dispose of Freon. To save on removal costs, it is recommended residents have the company delivering the new appliance dispose of the old appliance.
