**The contract shall commence July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026, for an initial term of three (3) years, with up to two (2) one-year option renewals at the Borough’s discretion as provided in the bid documents. Council further authorizes the Borough Manager and Solicitor to finalize and execute the Contract and any required bonds/insurance documents consistent with the bid documents and the awarded bid components.**
